Awareness Session on Ragging Prevention and Drug Abuse



Report on Anti-Ragging and Anti-Drug Abuse Awareness Program

World Pharmacists day

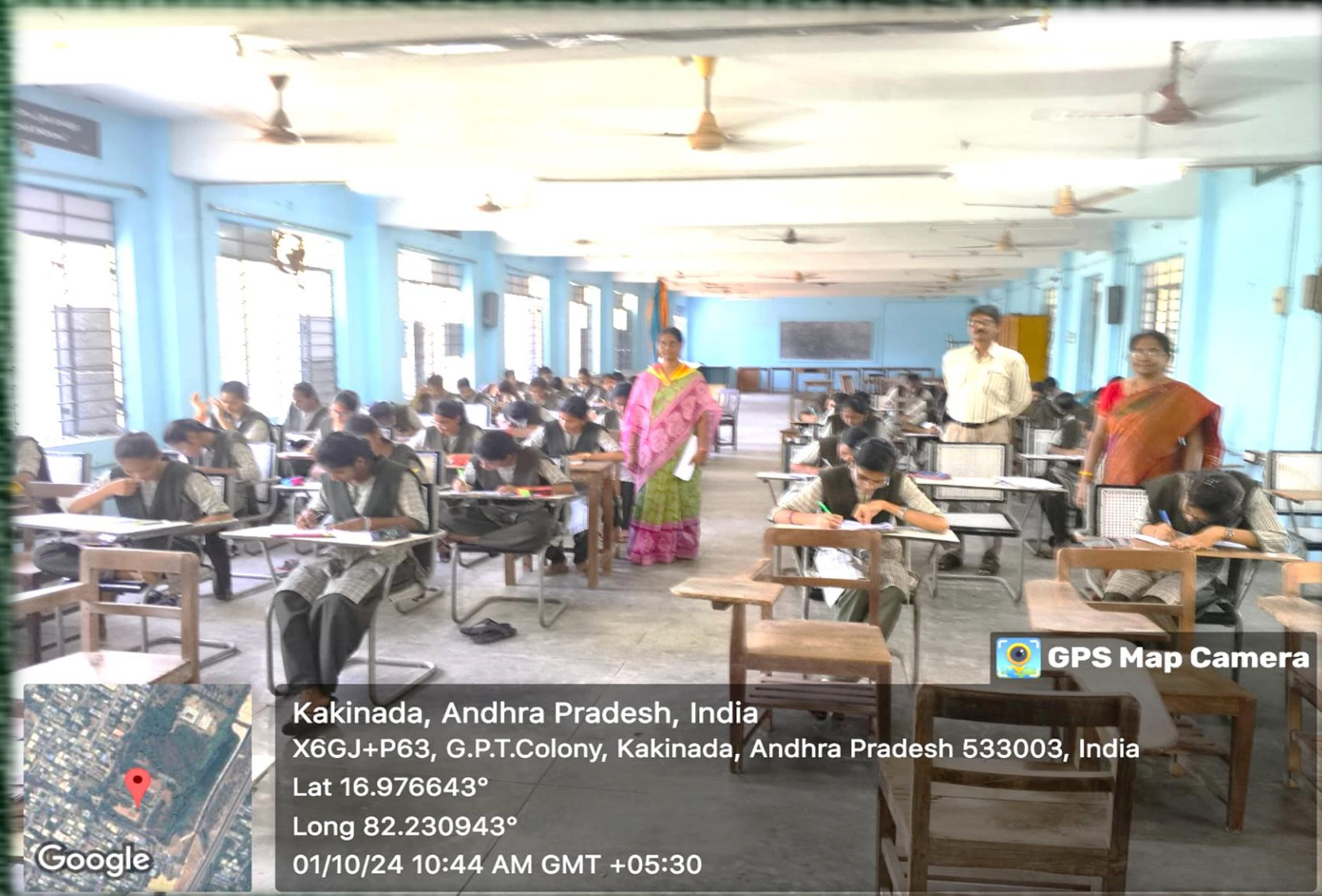
