# MEGA PARENT-TEACHER MEETING 2.0 ON 10-07-2025

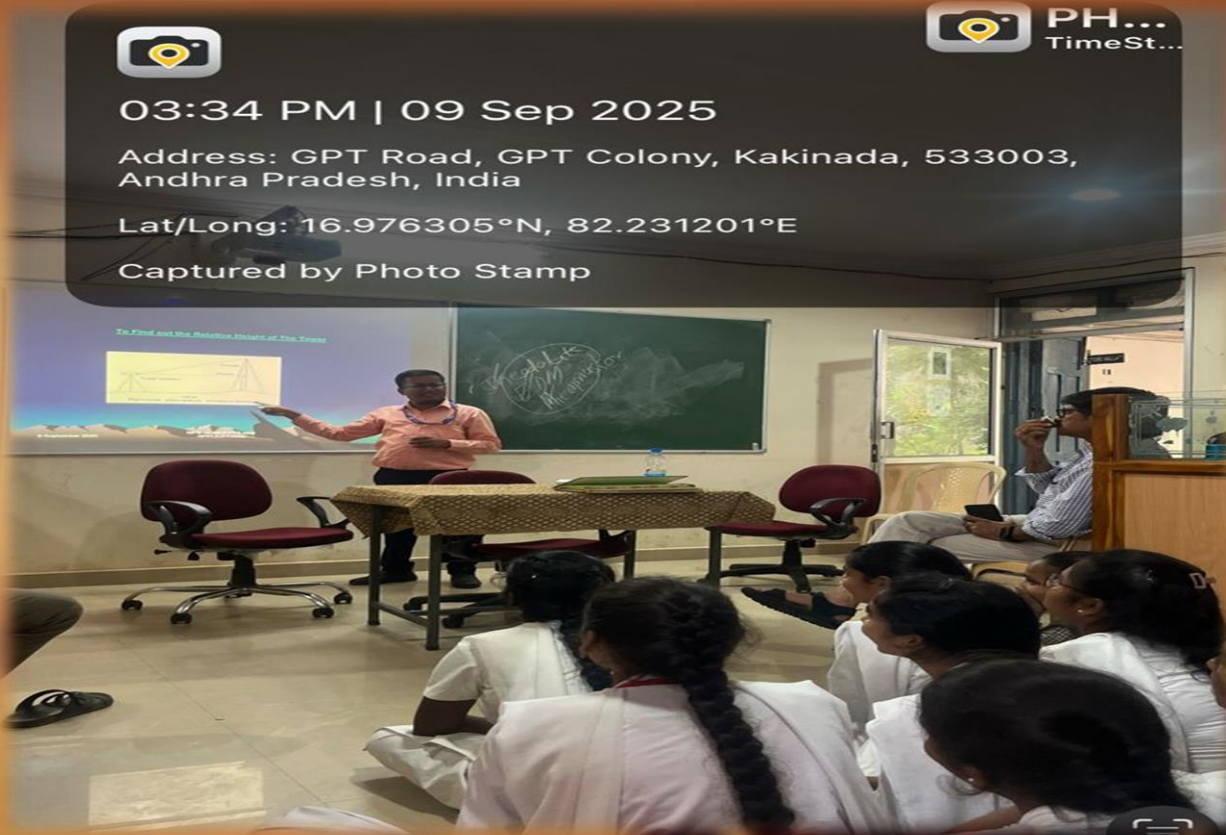


As per the instructions given by Honourable Education Minister and the District Collector a Mega PTM 2.0 is conducted on 10-07-2025.
